For example: If your school's goal for the year is reducing F rates, let your staff know about School Loop's High Priority Groups where teachers can communicate with each other about students at risk of failing. Flexible Training Options

School Loop has several training options. One of the options for training your staff in a flexible way is the **Getting Started Teacher Training Module**.

The movies can be viewed in a group setting or can be viewed individually. The Getting Started module is also helpful for new teachers that may have missed a previous training.
